- 1. Public Comments:** There were no public comments.

Stanley would like an adult volunteer to be a liaison to each school. J. Cesaitis does not see a communication problem in the elementary schools. We need to focus on the 7th grade. We need to be a part of Step Up Day. How can we get those kids into Husky Pride? Have the high school students welcome the 7th graders. J. Cesaitis said at another school the high school students stand on both sides of the long entrance to the school and clap and cheer the first day of school. E. Stanley and H. Blood loved the idea and suggested getting the coaches, the band and chorus involved. They would like to talk to J. Rathbun and B. Russell regarding the Step-up Day and bringing Husky Pride to the students. J. Cesaitis also suggested the expansion of the Husky Pups.
