Everyday items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Pencils (at least 48 pencils suggested) ● 1 package of colored pencils, markers, or crayons ● Erasers (large rubber or pencil cap) ● Pencil pouch <p>Students need to choose ONE of the following organizational systems for handouts from each class:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Binder with 5 divider tabs ● 5 durable, plastic folders ● Accordion file organizer with 5 sections <p>Please choose ONE of the above that will work best for you.</p>
Homeroom - <i>all items are required.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 5-10 boxes of tissues ● 1 pack of disinfecting wipes ● 1 pair of WIRED earbuds/headphones ● 2 combination locks (hallway and gym lockers)

Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <u>Mr. Kamagate</u>: 1 composition notebook ● <u>Mr. Blankenship</u>: 1 graph paper ("quad ruled") composition notebook ● <u>Mr. Blankenship</u>: 1 pack colored pencils ● 2 glue sticks ● 50 pencils (in addition to the homeroom amount) ● 1 durable 2 pocket folder with prongs (plastic, not paper if possible) ● 2 packs of highlighters ● 1 pair <u>wired</u> earbuds or headphones (see Homeroom list).
Social Studies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Colored pens for note taking (non "bleeding", please) ● 1 100 pack of lined index cards ● 2 packs of post-it notes ● 1 subject spiral notebook ● 1 box gallon size baggies ● 2 glue sticks
