**SSI DISABILITY EXEMPTION FORM

Based upon the ballot measure placed by the Las Virgenes Unified School District for the November 3, 2015 election, any resident who is receiving Supplemental Security Income (SSI) for a disability and who owns/or jointly owns a parcel as defined in the tax assessor's parcel file within the Las Virgenes Unified School District and uses that parcel as his or her principal place of residence shall qualify for exemption from paying the \$98 annual parcel tax. By statute as contained in Government Code 50079, a resident on disability is defined as anyone receiving Supplemental Security Income (SSI) for a disability, regardless of age. The Board of Education of the Las Virgenes Unified School District will automatically grant such an exemption upon filing of this application, together with appropriate proof of SSI disability benefits, and provided all information contained in the application is true and correct.
