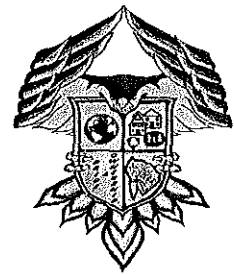

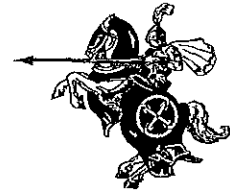
SPORTS

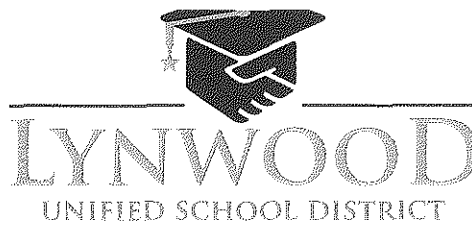

Board President Ms. Renteria, Members of the Board of Education, Superintendent Paul Gothold, Lynwood Unified School District officials, fellow students, friends, and family members. Good evening.

My name is Denise Renee Evans, and I am the Associated Student Body President at Lynwood Community Adult School.

On Wednesday, March 9, 2016, the Adult School honored over sixty students of the month at the Atlantic site, and on Thursday, March 10 at 6pm at the Imperial Site. The students were chosen for their superior academic performance, consistent attendance, and positive contributions to the learning environment. To memorialize their achievements, pictures were taken of each student and are now prominently displayed at each location. Further, each student of the month was given a Certificate of Achievement, and they were singularly recognized by their teachers in the classroom. The Student of the Month program has proven to be very popular among adult students.

The HiSET examination will be administered Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, April 11, 12, and 13. So far to date, over 90 students have registered and have taken the HiSET examination at the Adult School. The Adult School's Pearson Vue Lab is now open and students will also be able to take the GED test if they desire. Students wishing to take the GED test should register online at www.gedtestingservice.com. The California Department of Education now recognizes three examinations to be equivalent to a High School Diploma: the General Educational Development (GED) test, the High School Equivalency Test (HiSET), and the Test Assessing Secondary Completion (TASC).

On Wednesday, March 23, 2016, the Adult School will host its Community Advisory Committee meeting at 8:30am at the Atlantic Site. Community members, business members, student representatives, faculty members, community based organization representatives, and administration will meet to discuss important educational issues. The Adult School would like to invite members of the Board of Education and LUSD Administration to join us in this discussion.
