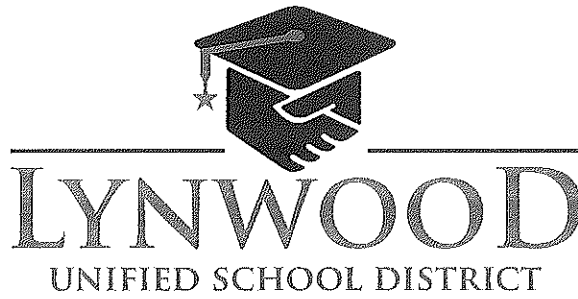



**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The administration requests approval to enter into an agreement with Parent Project Facilitator to continue parenting classes at Lynwood High School (LHS) for the 2015-2016 school year.

The Parent Project program is a court-approved parenting class which could be mandated for parents to attend if they have a SART/SARB contract or if they have mandated interventions through the Los Angeles County Courts. At LHS, teachers recommend families whom they have identified as needing additional assistance because their situations may be impeding their ability to succeed academically. Some teachers have also recommended students and their families who may benefit from learning how to foster positive relationships.

Classified staff members of the School Attendance Recovery Team have been trained by the Parent Project program to facilitate the sessions, in both English and Spanish. Childcare will be provided during the evening sessions (6:00pm - 9:00pm).

Cost includes consulting services, instructional materials, child care and refreshments.

- Reno Jazz Festival (RJF) - April 29-31, 2016, in Reno, NV


Costs for lodging and transportation will be funded through fundraising and parent donations. District personnel are included as chaperons and lodging will be provided.

The LACOE Academic Decathlon is open to public and private high school students to compete in academic tests and demonstrations as team members.

The Academic Decathlon is, like its ancient Greek counterpart, a 10-event contest. Unlike the Greek Decathlon, however, the Academic Decathlon is an academic, team and individual competition. Participants demonstrate their academic strength by completing seven written tests, writing an essay, delivering a prepared and an impromptu speech, and participating in an interview.

Students will also participate in the exciting Super Quiz oral relay; a team event held before a live audience. Each team consists of three "A" (honor), three "B" (scholastic), and three "C or below" (varsity) students. Awards are presented to the top teams as well as the top individual students in each event.

The cost includes the participation fee, scrimmage fee, and meals.

The goal of this curriculum is that students will understand how slaves were and are controlled through coercion manifested both physically and/or psychologically, and will understand the similarities and differences of historical and modern-day slavery.

The professional development course on human trafficking for teachers, administrators, security, counselors, and other school personnel is designed to help staff know how to respond to questions or concerns regarding the curriculum on human trafficking education for secondary school students.

**Memorandum of Understanding

Compensation Agreement 2015-2016  
December 4, 2015**

The Lynwood Unified School District Governing Board a school district duly formed and existing under the laws of the State of California ("District"), and the Lynwood Teachers Association a duly recognized bargaining unit ("LTA"), hereby enter into this Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") regarding the provision of an increase in compensation, subject to ratification by LTA membership and the District's Board of Education, and any necessary approvals by the Los Angeles County Office of Education with reference to the following:

**WHEREAS**, the parties entered into a successor collective bargaining agreement (CBA) for the period of July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2016, and

**WHEREAS**, the parties have the right under the existing collective bargaining agreement to negotiate compensation, health and welfare, and two articles of each parties choosing for the 2015-2016 year, and

**WHEREAS**, the parties have a joint and mutual interest in immediately resolving the issue of compensation, Article VIII: Salary and Salary Schedule Rules & Regulations, for members of the bargaining unit for the 2015-2016 school year, without penalty and reserving the right to continue to negotiate on issue of compensation and other open articles consistent with the existing collective bargaining agreement.

**WHEREAS**, on August 25, 2015 the Board of Education approved the MOU and authorized staff to implement and seek to provide compensation consistent with the agreement of the parties and/or needs of the District.

**NOW, THEREFORE** with references to the recitals above, which are incorporated herein and made a part of this MOU, the District and LTA hereby agree to amend, modify amend and revise Article XIII, Compensation as follows:

1. Members of the LTA bargaining unit in paid status as of December 1, 2015 shall receive a 5% on schedule salary increase effective July 1, 2015. Disbursement of the said salary, increase inclusive of the retro pay will be in January 2016.
2. A 4% one time, off-schedule bonus, which shall be applied after the 5% on schedule increase, shall be effective July 1, 2015. Disbursement of said bonus to bargaining unit members shall be done no later than December 18, 2015.


3. Members of the LTA bargaining unit in paid status as of December 1, 2015 shall receive an additional 1% on schedule salary increase effective December 1, 2015 to be reflected on the first pay period of January 2016.
  
4. The parties agree that either party may request to continue to bargain Article VIII: Salary and Salary Schedule Rules & Regulations, Health and Welfare and to continue to bargain the two articles of the parties' choosing upon request. The parties also reserve the right to continue bargaining all remaining open issues when negotiating the successor collective bargaining agreement (CBA) for the 2016-2017 school year.



## **RESOLUTION 15-16/12** HONORING MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., changed our Nation forever through his leadership, service, and clarity of vision; and

**WHEREAS**, in the brief time Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. walked upon this earth, he devoted his life to strengthening the content of the American character and called on our Nation to live up to its founding principles of life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness for all its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, on Friday, January 15, 2016, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. would have been 87 years of age; and

**WHEREAS**, one hundred years after the Emancipation Proclamation, on August 28, 1963, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and others organized hundreds of thousands of blacks and whites, Jews and gentiles, Protestants and Catholics, in a march to the Lincoln Memorial in Washington, DC where Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. made his famous "I Have a Dream" speech announcing that the days of segregation in the United States were numbered; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and the Civil Rights Movement helped change public policy from segregation to integration, resulting in the repeal of the post-Reconstruction era state laws mandating racial segregation in the South known as the "Jim Crow Laws," thereby leading to the passage of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Voting Rights Act of 1965, and other antidiscrimination laws aimed at ending economic, legal, and social segregation in America; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and the Civil Rights Movement helped change public policy from legal and socially acceptable discrimination and segregation to an open and accessible policy of racial integration leading to equal participation and access to primary and higher education, housing, employment, transportation, federal, state, and local governmental elections, and other aspects of public policy relating to human rights; and

**WHEREAS**, through his determination, spirit, and resolve, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. helped lift souls and lead one of the greatest movements for equality and freedom in history; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 10, 1970, California became the first state to pass legislation making Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday a school holiday and, subsequently, a statewide holiday; and

**WHEREAS**, January 20, 1986, marked the first observance of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day; and

**WHEREAS**, the unfinished business of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and the Civil Rights Movement was and is the plight of the poor, the fight against war and for worldwide peace, and the struggle for a fair, equitable, and sensible economic system; and

**WHEREAS**, fueled by President Obama's call to service, the 2009 King Day of Service experienced a historic

level of participation, as Americans across the country honored Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr by serving their communities on the January 19th King Holiday. In total, more than 13,000 projects took place, more than doubling the 2008 record of 5,000 projects; and

**WHEREAS**, Monday, January 18, 2016, marks the 30th national celebration of the national holiday for Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and his fight for civil and human rights; and

**WHEREAS**, in celebrating the expressions of our differences, we delight in the spirit that unites individuals throughout our community and schools; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lynwood Unified School District wishes to honor the lasting legacy of this great American, remember the ideals for which he fought, and recommit ourselves to ensuring that our country's promise extends to all Americans across the great land; and

**WHEREAS**, as we observe Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr's birthday, the Lynwood Unified School District encourages all Americans to celebrate his memory by performing acts of kindness through service to others.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Lynwood Unified School District, that all students and citizens be encouraged to honor Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr by living out his teachings as we continue to work for the day when the dignity and humanity of every person is respected; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Monday, January 18, 2016, be observed as the official memorial of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birth and his work in the Civil Rights Movement; and



Item passed with 5-0 votes.


