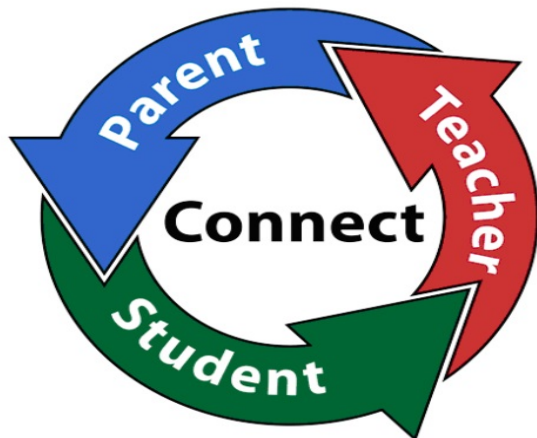

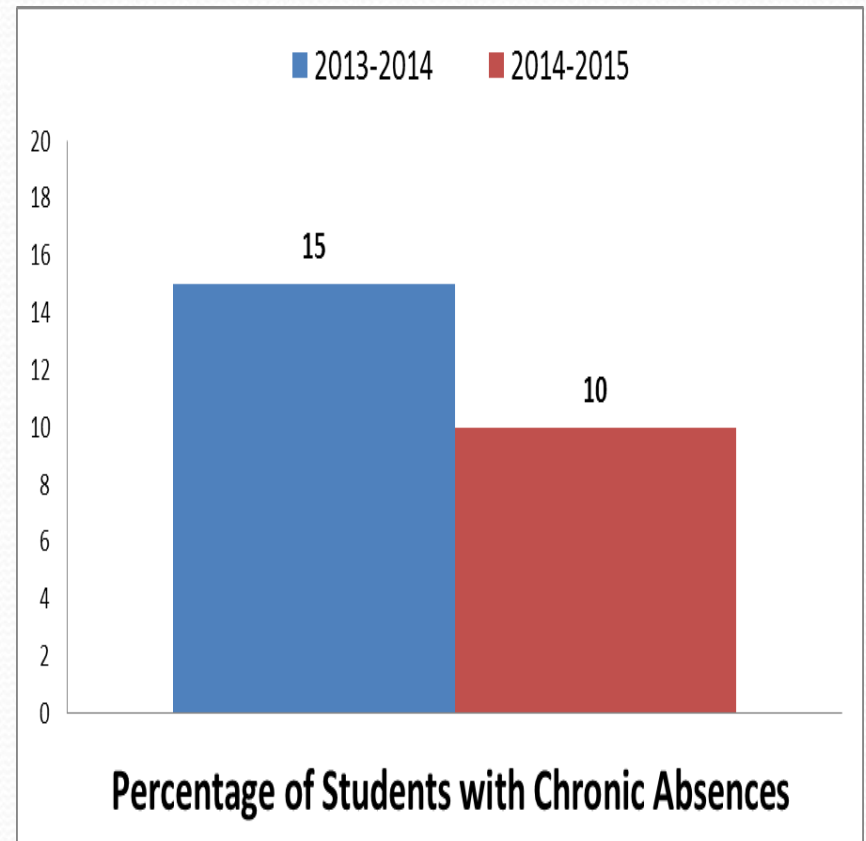

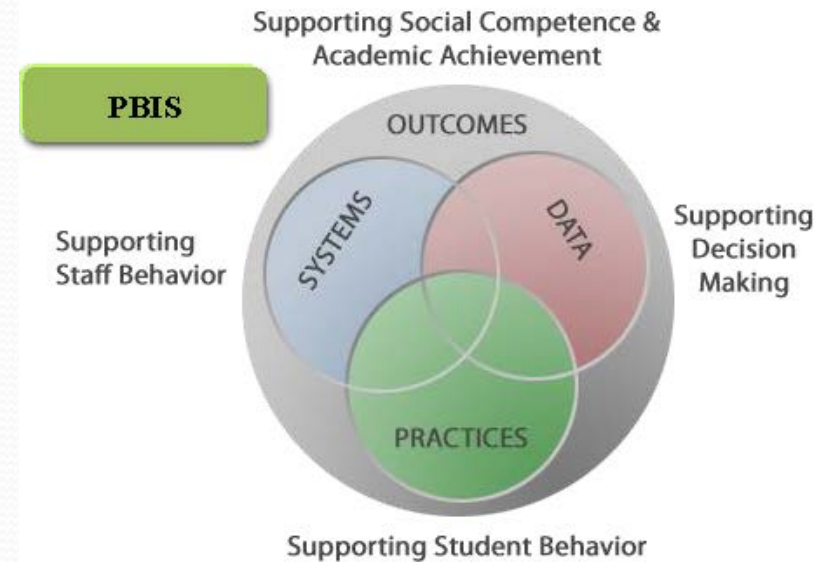
# STUDENT BEHAVIOR AND DISCIPLINE



- Students Suspended from School are .....
  - ☑ 5 times more likely to drop out of school
  - ☑ 6 times more likely to repeat a grade
  - ☑ 3 times more likely to have contact with the juvenile justice system

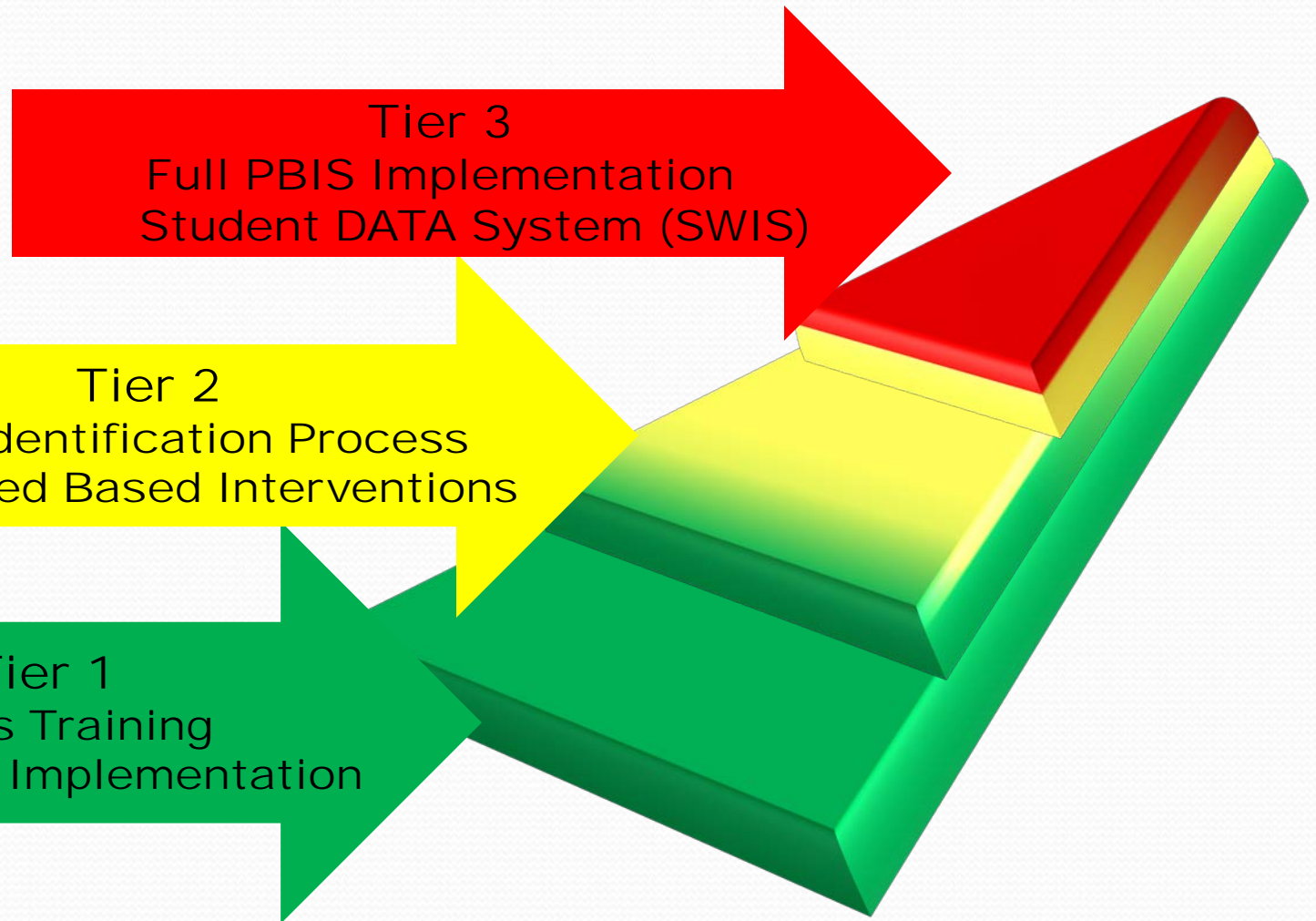

## Outcomes

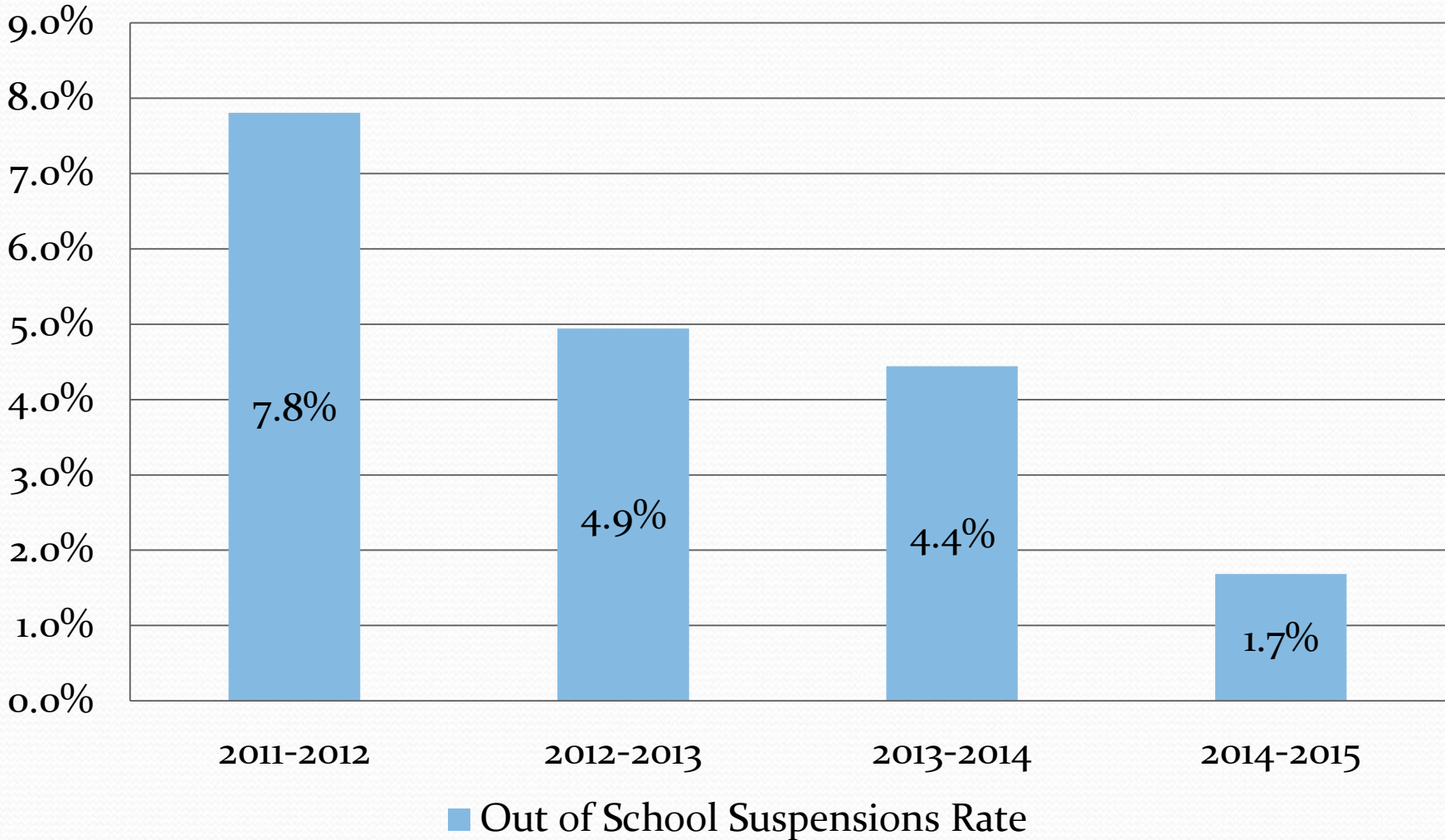

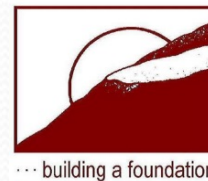
