Lower Dauphin includes all income sources that are taxable by the State of Pennsylvania.

You must first have an Occupation or Earned Income to be subject to paying the School Occupation Tax. Be advised that if you have rental income your occupation is "Landlord".

Earned Income means all types of payments for services rendered or to be rendered in the future, whether received in cash or in the form of property, services or other things of value. Earned Income includes salaries, wages, fees, tips, gratuities, commissions, bonuses, net profits from the operation of a business, profession or farm, incentive payments, vacation or holiday pay, termination or severance pay, sick pay (unless excluded), stock options, educational stipends, meals and lodging not provided for the convenience of the employer, reimbursement in excess of allowable business expenses and other income received for services rendered. Refer to your local tax return to determine your annual "Earned Income".

<u>Unearned Income</u> (other sources taxable by the State of Pennsylvania) to be added to your Earned Income to compute \$6,000 limitation for exemption are as follows: 1) Interest; 2) Dividends; 3) Rents, Royalties, Patents and Copyrights; 4) Income from Estates and Trusts; and 5) Gambling and Lottery Winnings, including prizes of the Pennsylvania state lottery. You must have Earned Income in order to include these Unearned Income sources towards your LD exemption limit. If you have no earned income you are exempt with no limit on the amount of allowable Unearned Income.

Excluded income (PA tax exempt): Disability, Worker's Compensation, Pensions collected during retirement, Public Assistance, Unemployment, Child support and Alimony.
