\*Undesignated positions to meet site needs must be reviewed and approved by Educational Services and the Board of Education and reported to CUEA.

All stipends are paid for extra duties and are paid on a monthly basis effective March 1, 2023, except for coaching stipends which will be paid seasonal (see chart above).

Extended Season – An extended season stipend of 10% per week (Monday – Sunday) will be provided to all varsity coaches, declared at the start of the season, who directly coach athletes still in CIF-sanctioned playoff competition.

The designated coaching stipends for Cheer/Traditional (Levels II and III), Cheer/Stunt (Levels II and III), eSports (Level III), Flag Football (Levels II and III), and Water Polo Girls and Water Polo Boys (Levels II and III) shall only be available for the designated sports and are not subject to allocation to other sports, activities, and/or positions should any of the designated positions be unfilled.

\*\*\* The stipends for Choral Director (Level II), Drama (Level II), Academic Competition Advisor (Level I), Assistant Drama Coach (Level I), Journalism Advisor (Level I), Forensics Advisor (Level I), and Yearbook Advisor (Level I) shall be moved to Appendix B – Stipends. These stipends shall only be available for the designated sport/activity/position and are not subject to allocation to other sports, activities, and/or positions should the designated position be unfilled. \*\*\*
