Bus Conduct

Dear Parent:

The Central Unified School District is pleased to provide bus transportation to a large number of its students. To enjoy the PRIVILEGE, each student must in turn accept certain RESPONSIBILITIES with regard to conduct on or near the school bus. Misconduct distracts the driver, which can jeopardize the safety of all passengers. Any violation of the bus regulations, continued disobedience, or willful misconduct on the part of a student is cause for denial of bus riding privileges.

Depending on the severity of misconduct, the level of consequences administered may result in permanent removal from bus. DENIAL OF BUS PRIVILEGES IS NOT A LEGAL EXCUSE FOR MISSING SCHOOL. In the event of a suspension of bus privileges, the school of attendance will contact the student's parent or guardian giving the number of days of the suspension, the effective date, and the date when the student can return to riding the school bus. *For the duration of the suspension it will be the parent or guardian's responsibility to provide transportation to and from school or school activities.* A STUDENT, WHO HAS BEEN SUSPENDED FROM BUS PRIVILEGES, SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED TO BOARD ANY SCHOOL BUS. The third notice of unsatisfactory conduct will result in an automatic suspension of bus riding privileges for the remainder of the school year.
