Your child's vision was screened on:

Vision screening is routinely conducted in schools as required by State law. This screening is performed to determine if your child has a vision problem that could interfere with learning.

Vision screenings do not take the place of a complete eye exam by an optometrist or ophthalmologist.

Your child **DID NOT Pass** the vision screening. It is important that you follow up and schedule your child for a complete eye exam.

Steps to follow:

- 1. Schedule an eye exam with an optometrist or ophthalmologist in your area.
- Take the attached EYE SPECIALIST REPORT form with you to the appointment.
- 3. Have the eye specialist complete the form
- 4. Return the completed form to school so the recommendations can be followed at school to benefit your child's learning.

Contact your School Nurse if you need further help with:

- Locating an eye specialist
- Paying for the examination
- Paying for glasses
- Have questions about your child's vision screening

If your child is already receiving eye care from a professional, please have the **Eye**Specialist Report form completed by the specialist and return it to the school.
