

2025/2026 LV1 Primary - Classroom Supplies Checklist

It is important for your child to have each of the following supplies available for their first day of school, so that they can learn and participate in the routines of our environment from their first moments (it is a greater difficulty to relearn routine due to lack of necessary items.)

Please send these items in for your child's first full day of school

- ❑ **Two wet bags***. These will be used to store and transport any soiled clothing that then need to change out of during the course of the school day. (5/6 year old students need only one.)
- ❑ **A change of clothing***. The needed items are one each of: shirt, pant, undergarment, pair of socks, and two masks – all character free.
- ❑ **Classroom Shoes***. Each day students change out of their 'home' shoes and into shoes designated specifically for use in the classroom. The best type of shoe for this is a soft sole shoe, as this type benefit's a child's development of balance and coordination as they grow and benefits their refinement of movement in the classroom.

- ❑ **Rainwear – hooded coat & pair of boots***. A portion of our classroom is out of doors and we use the playground in all types of weather (except for inclemently unsafe). Raincoats and rainboots will be kept at school and are also to be character free.
- ❑ **A blanket*** for resting (full day students only) to fit your child and a cot sized at 23" X 52".
- ❑ **Daily Lunch Gear*** (students who are full day and afternoon status only). Our students provide their own lunch each day. A [character free lunch box](#) (no backpacks, please) will be needed for transport. Lunch foods can be sent in individual containers (bento boxes are not a good option). Containers with [soft, flexible lids](#) are the easiest for students to manipulate.

*** It is Important to label all of your child's personal belongings with their name – particularly their wet bags, rain coat, and rain boots.**

Also, please know that items your child does not need to bring into school include: backpacks, water bottles, pillows, and toys.
