Live Lessons in Zoom

- Students participate in frequent online live lessons with their teacher and classmates. The purpose of these meetings is to provide instructional support for every BCVS student.
- Live lessons will last approximately 30-45 min. Additional optional Live Lessons will be offered throughout the week. Teachers are always available to support.
- 6th-8th grade students **are expected to attend 1 Math Live Lesson, 1 Reading Live Lesson, and 1 Science/History Live Lesson each week.**
- 9th-12th grade students **are required to attend 1 Live Lesson per week for all End-of-Course (EOC) tested subjects (ELA I & II; Math I, II, & III; Biology, U.S. History).** All HS students are highly encouraged to attend all other Zoom lessons for their non-EOC tested courses, and are required if earning a D or F.

Clubs & Organizations

- Students can participate in many BCVS Clubs / Organizations--both online & in-person!
- Bradley County Virtual School students may participate in sports / band / or chorus with the zoned BCS school.

Registration Process

- Parent /Guardian completes the [Registration Form](#).
- BCVS will request student grades and attendance from current school and contact family on acceptance status
- Eligibility: Students should have and maintain a 3.0 grade point average GPA. BCVS students should complete all assigned coursework, have fewer than 10 absences per school year, and attend all required Live Lessons.
- Eligibility for students with an IEP is contingent upon availability of identified modifications and accommodations in the virtual learning environment. BCVS staff and the BCS Special Services Team will work collaboratively to assess each situation individually.

Technology

- Chromebooks are available for every student to check out for the school year. In person and remote technology support is available for student and families
