### 9. Orientation for New G1

# 11. Financial Aid Program

### 1. Purpose

The purpose of this program is to support families whose children are high achievers as defined by the school, but who are unable to continue their studies at the school for financial reasons.

### 2. Selection Process

Applicants who meet the criteria will be selected based on a comprehensive judgment, including but not limited to the entrance exam results. They will be notified whether they are selected or not within the announcement of acceptance .

### 3. Tuition Fee

Students admitted with a scholarship will be partially exempted from the following items in the attached "List of Tuition and Other Fees" for all six years of Elementary School.

- (\*1) [Sibling discount] Admission Fee ¥300,000
  - It is required that a sibling be enrolled in G1-G12 in the year of admission.
- (\*2) [Sibling discount] If three or more children are registered at Elementary School (Kobe) and Secondary School simultaneously, one student's tuition fee will be cut by 50%. This discount will be applied in order of the eldest child first. If you have already received a discount, it will not be applied.
- \*Transfer students will be charged an additional transfer fee of ¥15,000 at the time of enrollment. [Miscellaneous Costs]
  - Students will be required to purchase devices, such as iPads, separately. (two devices must be purchased during the course of elementary school, one at the time of admission, and one in the upper grades of elementary)
  - Fees for textbooks, field trips, and after school classes will be paid on a monthly basis.
  - In the case of transfer students in G4 and above, only those students who achieve a passing grade in the English and Japanese language classes up to the first term of G6 will be treated as internal students at the time of admission to the secondary school.
  - An optional Summer School is held for an additional fee during the summer break.
- Admission fees, facility fees, tuition and other fees are non-refundable for any reason. Other miscellaneous fees may be charged at any time.
- We Due to changes in the economic situation or national policies (such as changes in consumption tax or corporate tax), we may have to revise the tuition fees and other fees accordingly. In this case, we will inform you as soon as possible.
