NOTICE TO PARENTS OF SCHOOL-AGE CHILDREN

In accordance with IDEA and Massachusetts Chapter 71B, Carlisle Public Schools provides special education programs designed to meet the needs of children attending not only public schools, but also children in Carlisle attending private school at private expense. In addition, children of migrant or homeless families are entitled to public education.

Carlisle provides all children with an opportunity to participate in public school programs and strives to identify all children with disabilities who are in need of special education services. Carlisle Public Schools will arrange for the screening and evaluation of any students ranging from age three through students in eighth grade who are unable to progress effectively in general education because of a disability consisting of a developmental delay or an intellectual, sensory, neurological, emotional, communication, physical, specific learning and/or health impairment.
