

## HINSDALE CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL

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Dear Parent/Guardian,

The Illinois School Code requires that each student entering high school as a freshman or a transfer student must have:

1. **Certificate of Child Health Examination:** The State of Illinois physical and immunization record must be completed within one year of the first day of school. This includes all transfer students.

- **Health History Section:** A parent/guardian must complete, sign, and date this portion of the Certificate of Child Health Examination form.
- Physical Examination Section: An MD, DO, PA or APN must complete, sign and date the form. A sports physical may not be used as the required 9th grade physical; however, the Certificate of Child Health Exam will serve as the sports physical for all freshman and transfer students.
- **Immunization Record:** This section must include all vaccines since birth and must be signed by a healthcare provider. The DuPage County Health Department offers vaccinations at a reduced cost 630.682.7400.

2. **Dental Examination:** The School Code of Illinois also requires that incoming freshman students have an oral health examination that is signed by a licensed dentist. Each child is required to present proof of examination to the health office prior to May 15th of the school year. The dental examination must have been completed within the 18 months prior to the May 15th deadline.

3. **OPTIONAL: Medication Authorization Form:** If your child requires any prescription or nonprescription medication (including Acetaminophen and Ibuprofen) during school, this form must be signed each school year by both the parent/guardian and a physician.

- 4. If your child has a special health need, please contact the building nurses to discuss the condition.
- \* Our District follows a First Day Exclusion Policy. Students with missing meningococcal conjugate vaccines will be excluded from entering school on the first day.
- \* Arrange for an appointment with your physician as soon as possible! Please submit health information via email or fax to the Health Office. Once submitted, the health office will notify you of any missing information. Please contact us with any questions.
