SUMMARY

As part of a secondary teaching assignment, teaches on or more classes in physical education to pupils in grades 7-8, and assists in other school programs as assigned.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Teaches knowledge and skills in physical fitness, health education, rhythms and dance, and individual, dual, or team sports to secondary pupils, utilizing course of study adopted by the Board of Trustees and other appropriate learning activities.
2. Instructs pupils in citizenship, basic communication skills, and other general elements of the course of study common to all teachers, as specified in state law and administrative regulations and procedure of the school district.
3. Works cooperatively with other physical education teachers in planning a balanced physical education program, adopting daily schedules to accommodate weather conditions and to provide time for changing clothes, showers, instruction, exercise, and sports activities.
4. Analyzes, demonstrates, and explains basic skills, knowledge, and strategies of formal sports, games, rhythms, and fundamentals of body movement.
5. Provides individualized and small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of each pupil to the extent feasible.
6. May teach one or more classes of adapted physical education for students with orthopedic and/or medical problems. May teach one or more classes in inter-scholastic athletics (boys or girls) to senior high pupils.
7. Provides appropriate safety instruction and makes safety checks on equipment and fields areas to insure the overall safety of pupils.
8. Maintains surveillance over storage and use of such items as school-owned uniforms, towels, lockers, equipment, and supplies to prevent loss and abuse, working through student monitors or locker room attendants where appropriate.
9. Establishes and maintains standards of pupil's behavior needed to provide an orderly, productive environment in the physical education areas.
10. Evaluates each pupil's growth in physical fitness and in physical skills and knowledge. Assesses each individual's contribution to the performance of the group on team sports. Prepares progress reports.
11. Maintains professional competence through participation in in-service education workshops and clinics provided by the district, and/or in self-selected professional growth
12. Other duties as assigned.
