### **SUMMARY**

Under the general direction of an assigned Principal or designee, to coordinate activities related to dance concerts and events which enhance students' classroom experience.

### **ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS**

- Schedule annual dance concerts and events
- Collaborate with site and/or district staff to arrange for the use of facilities
- Develop choreography and collaborate with district staff to determine lighting, sound, and set (as apply) needs for performances
- Demonstrate beginning to advanced dance steps.
- Conduct after school rehearsals
- Develop concert/event programs/flyers
- Inform parents of all scheduled activities in a timely manner
- Facilitate and attend all concerts/events
- Adhere to school district policies and procedures
- Perform related work as required

### **QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS**
