Training:

Formal training which ensures the ability necessary for successful job performance.

License Requirement:

Possess a valid California Driver's License

Condition of Employment:

Insurability by the District liability insurance carrier.

Education:

High school diploma or equivalent.

SUMMARY

Under certification supervision as assigned by the Director of the Visual and Performing Arts, provides technical assistance for district band/percussion classes and other special events.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Provide assistance for district band/percussion classes during and/or after school or weekends.
2. May accompany band/percussion classes to festivals, field shows, etc.
3. May schedule appointments with individual students for coaching and reinforce techniques taught in class.
4. Perform related duties and responsibilities as required.
5. Monitor and direct student activities in lunch areas, classrooms, play areas, restrooms, and other areas as assigned.
6. Enforce the District and school regulations; assure proper behaviors and safety regulations are maintained.

SPECIFIC QUALIFICATIONS

Must have a positive attitude, and strive for excellence; reassuring students' self-worth through positive reinforcement and encouragement, giving students a sense of pride and accomplishment; creating an educational environment plus adding value to the students' educational, performing and pageantry experience.

PHYSICAL ABILITIES

While performing the duties of this position, the employee is frequently required to sit, kneel, stand, stoop, communicate, reach, and manipulate objects. The position requires mobility.
