**EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE**

Must be 18 years or older. Any combination of experience and training that would likely provide the required knowledge and abilities is qualifying. A typical way to obtain knowledge and abilities would be:

**Education and Experience:**

BA/BS in music preferred. Minimum of one year providing accompaniment and music assistance preferred.

**Training:**

Formal training which ensures the ability necessary for successful job performance.

**License Requirement:**

Possess a valid California Driver's License

**Condition of Employment:**

Insurability by the District liability insurance carrier.

**Education:**

High school diploma or equivalent.

**SUMMARY**

Under certification supervision as assigned by the Director of the Visual and Performing Arts, provides musical accompaniment and/or assistance for district choirs, chamber singers, schools, recitals, drama classes, and other special events.

**SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES**

1. Provide accompaniment/assistance for district choirs and sight-read accompaniments in rehearsals.
2. Accompany choral concerts, special events, and music recitals.
3. May schedule appointments with individual students for coaching and reinforce techniques taught in class.
4. Perform related duties and responsibilities as required.
5. Monitor and direct student activities in lunch areas, classrooms, play areas, restrooms, and other areas as assigned.
6. Enforce the District and school regulations; assure proper behaviors and safety regulations are maintained.

**SPECIFIC QUALIFICATIONS**

Must have a positive attitude, and strive for excellence; reassuring students' self-worth through positive reinforcement and encouragement, giving students a sense of pride and accomplishment; creating an educational environment plus adding value to the students' educational, performing and pageantry experience. Drum Corps, college or serious high school experience preferred.

**PHYSICAL ABILITIES**

While performing the duties of this position, the employee is frequently required to sit, kneel, stand, stoop, communicate, reach, and manipulate objects. The position requires mobility.
