NOT move or twist the back or neck. 2. Is the student vomiting?			
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3. If Yes- Call 911			
4. If No- Watch student closely, Do not leave student alone.			
5. Are any of the following symptoms present?			
• Unconsciousness.			
• Seizure.			
• Neck Pain.			
• Blood is flowing freely from head.			
• Blood or watery fluid in ears.			
• Student is unable to respond to simple commands.			
• Student is unable to move or feel arms or legs.			
• Student is sleepy or confused. 6. If Yes- Call 911			
7. If No- Are any of the symptoms present?			
•Headache.			
•Blurred vision.			
•Balance problem.			
•Does not "feel right"			
8. If Yes- Contact Parent/Guardian and URGE MEDICAL CARE. Even if student was			
only briefly confused and seems fully recovered, contact Parent/Guardian URGE			
MEDICAL CARE Watch for delayed symptoms. Student may return to class if no			
complaints and exam is negative.Complete Head Bump/Injury Report Form and send			
with student			
9. If No - Student may return to class if after 15 minutes there are no complaints and			_
exam is negative. Complete Head Bump/Injury Report Form and send with student
