SUMMARY OF AWARDS & SCHOLARSHIPS

Instrumental Award 3: is intended for girls who have already made considerable progress towards higher levels of achievement in their instrument.

Choral Award: to encourage high standards of singing in both solo and choir work.

Organ Award: to encourage girls to learn the organ. Candidates should already be competent pianists.

Instrumental Award 1: to encourage girls to take up less familiar instruments, e.g. Viola, Double Bass, Oboe, Bassoon, French Horn, Lower Brass. *Please check availability before applying*

Sixth Form Music Scholarship: is awarded to a girl of proven high musical ability (approaching Grade 8 in her first instrument/voice would be expected as a minimum). Ability in a second instrument/voice would be a distinct advantage. The holder would be expected to take a full and active part in the School’s music. Different levels of Scholarship are available, depending on whether the applicant intends to take A Level Music.

Jennifer Bate Memorial Organ Scholarship with Guildford Cathedral: is offered to girls who are already advanced organists and who are intending to apply for organ scholarships, or further their organ studies, at university, conservatoire, or cathedrals post-18.
