Math Common Assessment 5.NBT.5

The common assessment was multiplying whole numbers using context. The four story problems were multi-step and required expressions, labels, organization, and accuracy. The assessments will be sent home Tuesday to families. **I highly encourage parents look over the child's work for review if their score was less than an 80%.**
