### Smarter Balanced Test Practice Links

### California Assessable Practice Tests Link

**Tests:** When a test has been graded and returned via Gmail, students should look at the questions they got incorrect, look at the feedback (expected solution with justification), go back and find their error(s), correct them on paper, then explain what was done different.

Have the following mastered:

Division and multiplication facts from 0-14

Place values from millions to thousandths

Adding and subtracting whole numbers and decimals with regrouping

Multiplying whole numbers and decimals

Dividing whole numbers and decimals

Comprehension, vocabulary, fluency, and writing

Read all novels pride and integrity. Picture the novels as a movie when reading.

Complete all vocabulary work
