Pittsburgh Public Schools Releases Schedule for Public Hearings on Recommended Building Closures Under Future-Ready Facilities Plan

District Plans Additional Opportunities to get Input

Pittsburgh, PA – July 3, 2025 – Pittsburgh Public Schools (PPS) today announced the schedule for upcoming public hearings on recommended building closures included in the District's Future-Ready Facilities Plan. This schedule announcement follows the Board of Directors' vote on June 23 to authorize the scheduling of public hearings. These public hearings provide students, families, staff, and community members with an opportunity to formally share feedback directly with the Board of Directors on recommended school closures.

As part of its approval, the Board has required both the presentation and approval of a detailed Implementation Plan from the Superintendent. No final decision to permanently close any school building will be made until the Board votes to approve the Reconfiguration Plan. The Public Hearing schedule is below.
