



Recommended Upper School Time Investment for Home Assignments

The information in the table below is a guide for teachers when planning weekly assignments. These times are for the typical student. It is important that teachers check in with students to understand the workload of students and when it appears to be more for the collective group, the teacher will make adjustments. However, when it appears to be more individualized in terms of much less time or much more time invested, students should consider slowing down and/or evaluating time management and distractions or the need for additional academic support systems.

HOPE Academy's posture is that students should be provided a manageable workload that allows them to learn the necessary content, while pursuing their gifts through work, athletics, friendships, and/or other pursuits, in addition to also getting a healthy night's sleep.
