Specialized Physical Health Care Services

The Governing Board is aware that some district students require specialized physical health care services during the school day in order to attend school. Such services shall be provided as required when the Superintendent or designee has determined that the services will fill the student's legitimate needs.

Trained and qualified school personnel shall perform these routine services under the supervision of a school nurse, in accordance with law.
