

## STUDENTS

### Accidents

Although every reasonable effort is made by the district to prevent accidents to students, it is inevitable that accidents will occur. The Superintendent or designee shall develop regulations and procedures which encourage prompt action to minimize the effects of the injury, to provide first aid and/or medical attention as quickly as possible, to notify parents/guardians of all accidents as deemed necessary, and take whatever other steps are deemed necessary in the interest of that student.
