Gun-Free Schools Act

Any student who is determined to have brought a firearm to school or to have possessed a firearm at school will be expelled for not less than one year in compliance with state and federal laws. If the governing board sets an earlier date for readmission, it will be on a case-by-case basis. Any student who brings a firearm or weapon to school will be referred to the criminal justice or juvenile delinquency system.
