Open/Closed Campus

Senior Open Campus

The Governing Board establishes a closed campus at all district schools, however seniors who meet eligibility requirements may use lunch passes to leave campus during the lunch hour. The Board views this program as a way to improve and reward student academic achievement and attendance. Eligibility requirements are based upon academic performance and attendance and discipline standards. The open campus privilege may be revoked for seniors who do not meet the eligibility standards.

Students shall not leave the school grounds at any other time during the school day without written permission of their parents/guardians and school authorities. Students who leave school or who fail to return following lunch without authorization shall be classified truant and subject to disciplinary action.

Student Travel Between Campuses

Students with a valid driver's license may drive from one campus to the other only with written release from their parents/guardians and school authorities. This privilege may be revoked by the school administration if the privilege is abused or misused and the student will be required to ride the bus back and forth between campuses. Seniors may not transport other students back and forth campuses.
