

# **2025-2026 Supply Lists**

#### **SECOND GRADE**

- 2 boxes of 24 crayons
- 3 dozen sharpened yellow #2 pencils
- 1 highlighter
- 2 large pink or white erasers
- 1 pair of scissors, pointed 5"
- **6** glue sticks
- 1 plastic pencil/crayon box
- 1 spiral notebook (70 ct wide ruled)
- 1 Primary Journal (SEE PICTURE) (½ page drawing, ½ page lined)
- **1 sturdy** 2-pocket folder (to be used as a take-home folder)
- **5 sturdy** 2-pocket folders with prongs: red, yellow, green, blue, purple
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 1 set computer headphones (earbuds not recommended)
- 1 protective smock for art please label with your child's name
- 4 dry erase markers (black preferred)
- 1 dry eraser (a sock or small cloth works well)
- 1 pack of 3x3 Post-It® notes
- 1 bottle of Elmer's Liquid Glue (white)
- GIRLS 1 box of quart size Ziploc bags &
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes
- **BOYS 1** box of gallon size Ziploc bags & **1** bottle of hand sanitizer
- \*Please DO NOT label supplies except for art smock & pencil boxes.



## **THIRD GRADE**

- **2** boxes 24 crayons (Crayola® preferred)
- **2** dozen **sharpened** yellow #2 pencils (*Dixon Ticonderoga* preferred)
- 2 highlighters
- 2 large pink or white erasers
- 1 plastic pencil/crayon box
- 1 box colored pencils
- 1 manual pencil sharpener
- 1 pair of scissors, pointed 5"
- 10 glue sticks (Elmers preferred, 28 oz only)
- **2** marble composition notebooks
- **6** plain 2-pocket folders (1 each: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple)
- 1 sturdy take-home folder w/2 pockets
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 1 bottle of small pump hand sanitizer (8 oz.)
- 1 clipboard
- 1 set computer earbuds or headphones
- 2 dry erase markers (fine tip, any color)
- 1 dry eraser (a wash cloth or fabric scrap works well)
- 1 protective smock for art (a large, old shirt works well)
- 1 water bottle (reusable or returnable)

#### **FOURTH GRADE**

- **2** dozen **sharpened** yellow #2 pencils (*Dixon Ticonderoga* preferred)
- 1 box of 24 colored pencils (sharpened)

- 2 highlighters, each a different color (your choice)
- 1 large pink or white eraser (opt.)
- 1 pair of scissors (that fits your child's hand)
- 4 small glue sticks
- 2 dry erase markers
- 1 dry eraser (a sock or small cloth works well)
- 1 12" ruler (cm & inches)
- 1 hand held pencil sharpener
- 1 pencil case or box (large enough to hold all writing utensils)
- 1 pkg. loose leaf paper (wide ruled)
- 2 marble composition notebooks
- **6** plain, 2-pocket folders (1 red, 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 orange, 1 purple, 1 blue)
- 1 heavy-duty pocket-folder for take home papers
- 1 container of Clorox®/Lysol® wipes, **OR** baby wipes (your choice)
- 1 set computer earbuds or headphones (not wireless)
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 1 protective smock for art (a large, old shirt works well)
