Provide a duty-free lunch period for every teacher on a daily basis. (A4.06)

Provide duty-free instructional planning time for every teacher under G.S. 115C-105.27 and -301.1, with the goal of providing an average of at least five hours of planning time per week, to the maximum extent that the safety and proper supervision of students may allow during regular student contact hours. Provide a positive school climate under CMS regulation JICK-R, by promoting a safe learning environment free of bullying and harassing behaviors. (A4.06)

The percent of 8th grade students who score at the College and Career (CCR) level -- a 4 or 5 -- on the Grade 8 Mathematics EOG will increase from 1.5% in SY2021-22 to 14.8% in SY2022-23 and 28% in SY2023-24.

We will meet or exceed expected Educator Value Added Assessment System (EVAAS) growth for our overall school index in SY2022-23 and SY2023-24. (Aligns to A4.01 and B3.03 and CMS Goal 4).

The percent of students reporting a positive self-perception of their self-efficacy will increase from 39% on the Fall 2021 Panorama Screener (in Grades 3-5/6-12) to 44.5% in SY2022-23 and 50% in SY2023-24.

Maintain the proportionality of our Out-of-School Suspension (OSS) data for Black students at 10.8% in SY2022-23 and 5.8% SY2023-24. (Aligns to A4.06 and CMS Guardrail 1)
