Mrs. Lois Bullock has distinguished herself as a brilliant educational leader and business woman.

Lois Bullock began her professional career at Texas Instruments, Incorporated in Houston, Texas. She later entered the field of higher-education at Texas Southern University where she was the Assistant Dean of Development and Assistant Professor in the Jesse H. Jones School of Business.

Deciding that she could combine business with educational endeavors, Lois opened Educational Learning and Enrichment Center, Inc. in 1984, providing educational and enrichment services to youth and adults. In 1998, in collaboration with the Houston Independent School District, Lois opened Energized for Excellence Academy, Inc. (EEA) an open enrollment charter school for elementary students. As the school grew and prospered, a middle-school was added in 2000.

In 2008, the Houston Independent School District solicited Mrs. Bullock to develop a program targeting overage middle-school students. Her response to this request was the establishment of two alternative middle schools: Inspired for Excellence Academy–West and Inspired for Excellence Academy–North.

With a keen sense for future educational needs, Mrs. Bullock recently opened two Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) schools: E-Stem High School Central, 2008; and E-STEM West 2009. E-STEM High School Central finished its first year of operation with a rating of “Recognized.”

These schools have received numerous accolades and honors including the middle school receiving the prestigious honor or being named as one of the two most distinguished Title I schools in Texas from a field of 5,900 eligible schools.

Mrs. Bullock’s prowess as a leader has been recognized on numerous occasions. She was selected by the Alternative District in 2005 as the HISD “Charter School Principal of the Year”; and in 2007, she was given the “Outstanding Leadership” Award by Region IV ESC. Lois gives credit to her ongoing success to her dedicated staff, friends, family and many supporters that have worked tirelessly over the years to support the mission of providing the best possible education to learners in the Houston community.

She was married to late Attorney James Bullock, retired professor of Law at Texas Southern University. The Bullocks are the parents of two sons, Joseph (deceased) and Brandon; granddaughter, Taylor Moore; and god children, Christopher Robinson, Terry Robinson, Kendahl Gardner Lucas, Bridnee King, Madison Belcher, and Sydney Yorke.
