

Truck Driver Training – Class A Unrestricted 2025-2026

Short Course Description:	The truck driver training (TDT) curriculum is designed to train students for entry level employment in the transportation field. This course blends curriculum prepared by J.J. Keller with the Ohio Commercial Driver Manual and is approved by the Ohio Department of Public Safety. Students will study control and vehicle systems in a classroom/lab setting. Examinations monitor students' progress, along with performance demonstrations in the hands-on portion of instruction.

Program Completion Requirements:	Complete all hours in order to test for CDL license.
