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Bear Family,

Although it is early summer, I want to take a moment to emphasize the critical importance of **consistent school attendance** for next school year in ensuring your child's academic success and overall development.

What is Chronic Absenteeism?

Chronic absenteeism is defined as **missing 10% or more of the school year for any reason**, excused or unexcused. In a typical 180-day school year, this means 18 or more absences.

At the high school level, especially within our **block scheduling model**, each day is equivalent to nearly **two days of instruction in a traditional schedule**. Missing even a single day in a core subject can significantly impact a student's understanding of the material and their ability to stay on track.

Why Attendance Matters: Key Facts

- Students who are chronically absent are far more likely to fall behind academically.
- In our school, 63% of all failed courses last year were from students identified as chronically absent.
- Students risk **losing course credit** in full-year classes after 10 absences, regardless of their academic ability. Losing credit is different than failing. Students can numerically pass a class, but earn zero credit due to not fulfilling attendance requirements.
- Chronic absenteeism also affects students' social connection, mental health, and sense of belonging in school.
