Dress Code Information & Details

PK Dress Requirements

Students in PK2, PK3, and PK4 do not have a specific dress code but should wear comfortable and clean clothing with sneakers. The Lower School uniform listed below is optional for PK students. We ask each PK student to bring:

- Two sets of backup clothes
- One set of rain boots.

K-8 Spirit Wear Fridays

Students may only wear appropriate bottoms of their choice on Friday and a Harbor spirit wear or uniform shirt.

- Spirit wear bottoms include jeans, sweatpants, leggings, and school-appropriate length shorts.
- Spirit wear tops can be purchased from the online store, or students can wear a uniform shirt. Shirts that do not contain a Harbor logo are not considered spirit wear and cannot be worn on Friday spirit days.

Daily Uniform Requirements for Kindergarten through Grade Four*

Choices include:

- Navy plaid jumper with white or green polo or short-sleeved t-shirt
- Khaki (only) pants, skorts, shorts, or skirts
- White or evergreen long or short-sleeved polo shirt, broadcloth shirt, or button-down shirt
- Evergreen (only) cardigan sweater, vest, or fleece
- White or navy tights, socks, or black or navy leggings, which may be worn under skirts or dresses
- Clean sneakers or comfortable shoes
- Athletic Sneakers for PE (can be worn daily)
- *Grade four students must purchase a PE uniform; please see the requirements below

K-4 Formal/Concert Dress

For all concerts and announced other events, students should wear:

- Khaki pants, skirt, or classic navy plaid jumper
- White, collared, or button-down shirt (tucked in)
- White socks or tights with skirts or jumpers with dress shoes
- Belt (with pants)
- Optional: Blazer and Tie

Daily Uniform Requirements for Grades Five through Eight

Choices include:

- Short-sleeved mesh polo dress in Navy Blue or Evergreen
- Khaki or navy blue pants, skorts, shorts, or skirts
- White or Evergreen long or short-sleeved polo shirt, broadcloth shirt, or button-down shirt
- Navy Blue or evergreen cardigan sweater, vest, or fleece
- White or navy tights, socks, or leggings in black or navy, which may be worn under skirts or dresses
- Clean sneakers or comfortable shoes

Physical Education Uniform – Grades Four through Eight
(to only be worn in PE, not during school)

Choices include:

- White or green short-sleeved t-shirt, evergreen athletic shorts
- Evergreen or navy hooded pullover sweatshirt, evergreen or navy sweatpants
- Black athletic pants
- Navy blue or black yoga pants
- White socks
- Athletic sneakers for PE (can be worn daily)
- Grades 7 and 8 need cleats (fall)
- Grades 5 through 8 need basketball sneakers (winter only)

5-8 Formal Dress

When a formal wear event is announced, students should follow the given requirements and options:

- Khaki or navy pants or a skirt
- White, collared, or button-down shirt (tucked in)
- White socks or blue or black tights if wearing a skirt
- Belt (with pants)
- Dark dress shoes
- Optional: blazer and tie

5-8 Concert Dress

For all concerts, students should wear:

- Black pants or a black skirt with a white dress shirt and black tights
- Black belt with pants
- Dark dress shoes
