### **TEACHER OF TOMORROW SCHOLARSHIPS**

The Fresno County Charter of the Association of California School Administrators will provide a scholarship to qualifying high school graduating seniors who plan to pursue a career in education.

*Selections will be based on:*

- Minimum 3.0 GPA (transcripts)- official transcript must be sent.
- Graduating high school senior
- Must be a member of a Teacher of Tomorrow Club, CTE Education Pathway, or Education Related Field of Study
- School and Community Activities
- Statement of college and career goals
- Letters (2) of reference (one must be from school personnel)

**The completed application must include:**

1. An ACSA Teacher of Tomorrow Scholarship Application form
2. A sealed copy of the applicant's school transcripts
3. Two letters of recommendation (one from school personnel and the other from a person of the applicant's choosing).

Scholarships will be awarded to the recipient at their school district upon invitation. Scholarship monies will be distributed by the Treasurer of the Fresno County ACSA Charter upon verification of college schedule for the fall year.
