This project is being Electronically Bid (E-Bid). General Bids shall be submitted online to www.BidNetDirect.com prior to **July 24, 2025, at 10:00 am**. All plan holders must have an active online account on www.bidnetdirect.com to acquire documents, receive project notifications, and to submit bids, electronically. It is the responsibility of prospective proposers to check www.BidNetDirect.com for new information via any addenda to this solicitation. A Mandatory Pre-bid walkthrough will be **July 16, 2025, at 10am**. Any addenda issued will be emailed to all plan holders registered with BidNetDirect. All Questions are due by **11:00 am. on July 18, 2025**.

A performance bond in an amount equal to 100 percent of the total amount of the contract price with a surety company qualified to do business in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts will be required for the faithful performance of the contract as well as a labor and materials bond in an amount equal to 100 percent of the total contract price.

All bids for this project are subject to applicable public bidding laws of Massachusetts, including G.L. c.149, § 44A through 44H, as amended.

Attention is directed at the minimum wage rates to be paid as determined by the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development and the weekly payroll record submittal requirements under the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws (M.G.L.), Chapter 149, Section 26 through 27D inclusive.

Attention is further directed to the requirements of M.G.L. c.149, §44D requiring submission of a Division of Capital Asset Management approved Certificate of Eligibility and Update Statement with all bids.

Selection of the contractor will be based upon bidder qualifications, including evidence of past performance in similar projects, and bid price. The contract will be awarded to the bidder deemed by the awarding authority to be the lowest responsible and eligible bidder.

The bidder agrees that its bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of 30 days, Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays excluded, after the opening of the bids.

The City reserves the right to waive any informalities, to accept or reject, in whole or in part, any or all bids, or take whatever other action may be deemed to be in the best interest of the City.

The City is an Equal Opportunity Employer and encourages MBE/WBE/DBE participation in response to the bid process.
