Carl's Cause Receives Top Honor from The University of Kansas Health System




Carl's Cause' is a 501 (c)(3) which promotes mental health awareness. It was created following the devastating loss of an amazing young man, Carl Specht at age 27.

Carl died by suicide on June 23, 2017 the result of depression, stigma that surrounds mental illness and the lack of access to care.
