

# SCHOOL MEAL INFORMATION

### MENU OFFERINGS

SMSD Student Nutrition Services offers a menu at breakfast and lunch meeting the USDA meal pattern requirements for a reimbursable meal. The menu, both at breakfast and lunch, offers a variety of entree selections and a choices bar with fruits, vegetables, juice and milk. Students will be encouraged to make reimbursable meal. #### What Makes a Reimbursable Breakfast?

A reimbursable breakfast must have a minimum of 3 items and one item must be a 1/2 cup of fruit or fruit juice. These items come from three food components-fruit, grain and milk.



#### What Makes a Reimbursable Lunch?

A reimbursable lunch must have 3 full components with one of those being a 1/2 cup of fruit OR a vegetable. The five food components offered at lunch are meat, grain, vegetable, fruit and milk.



#### Special Diet

For allergy or specific dietary concerns, contact the school nurse. A medical form must be completed by a doctor for meal modifications.

- Parents are encouraged to pay for meals in advance by making prepayments into their student's meal account. A meal account is automatically set up with a zero balance for each student upon enrollment in SMSD.
- The cost of school meals by month is available on the Student Nutrition Services Prices web page.
- Students' meal accounts stay active for as long as students remain enrolled in SMSD. Meal account balances (positive or negative) will follow the student within the SMSD district.

### MEAL PAYMENTS

- Payments can be made multiple ways.
  - Send a check or cash to the school with the student marked as lunch money, no transaction fee.
  - Pay online via eFunds - Choose Pay for Optional Fees to add funds to meal accounts, \$3.00 transaction fee per transaction.
  - Pay by phone by calling the Student Nutrition office - 7am to 4pm - 913-993-9710, no transaction fee.
- Students will be served a reimbursable meal whether the meal account balance is positive or negative
- Ala carte options are available but varies per school level. Students will not be permitted to purchase ala carte items if their account is negative.



#### › Negative Balances

- Households will receive automated phone calls for low meal account balances - \$8.00 for full price and \$2.00 for reduced priced meals.
- Households will receive automated phone calls and monthly emails for negative meal account balances
- Households will receive emails for negative meal account balances
- Twice a year, meal account balances over \$-75.00 will be turned over the collection's agency - December 31st and June 30th. Households will be given final notices via email with the opportunity to pay before being turned over.



#### › Child Nutrition Meal Benefit Application for Free or Reduced Priced Meals

Households are encouraged to complete a child nutrition meal benefit application to determine if they would qualify for free or reduced priced meals. Determination is based on income guidelines set by the USDA.

**Starting July 1, child nutrition meal benefit applications will be accepted online at [www.schoolcafe.com/SHAWNEEMISSION](http://www.schoolcafe.com/SHAWNEEMISSION).**

Processing the application can take up to 10 days.

**Families are responsible for any meals charged before the meal benefit application is approved.**

Qualifying for meal benefits allows a student to receive one breakfast and one lunch per day as well as other instructional fees may be waived or reduced.

Families who qualify for meal benefits can complete the Consent for Disclosure, <https://qrco.de/smsdconsent>, which allows Student Nutrition Services to share your student's meal benefit status for a reduction in fees including transportation and instructional fees.
