SUBJECT: RELEASE OF FY25 SCHOOL AND DISTRICT GRADES

On July 7, 2025, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) released the FY25 School and District Grades. The School District of Palm Beach County continues to be "A" rated in FY25.

During the FY23 school year, FDOE transitioned from the Florida Standards Assessments (FSA) to the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST). The FAST results provide the foundation for school grades based on a grading system adopted by the State Board of Education (SBOE). This grading system uses the percentage of total points earned across several components includes: achievement; learning gains for all students; learning gains for the lowest 25% of students; high school graduation rates; and acceleration success in middle and high school. In FY24, the grade 3 reading performance component was added for elementary and applicable combination schools as well as Districts. The present summary includes FY22, FY23, FY24, and FY25 results for comparison. Schools and districts are rated "A" through "F" based on a percentage of points earned. Table 1 details the grading scale.

A review of the FY25 preliminary School and District Grades revealed the following:

District Grades

- Palm Beach was among six of the seven largest Florida districts to earn an "A" grade.
- When compared with all 67 Florida school districts on points earned, Palm Beach was ranked 18th and one of 28 districts to receive an "A" grade.

School Grades

- For FY25, the results for traditional¹ District schools showed that:
 - 120 (71%) schools were rated “A” or “B,” up from 113 schools in FY24.
 - 91% of high schools were rated “A” or “B,” an increase of 17 percentage points from FY24.
 - 73% of middle schools were rated “A” or “B,” an increase of 15 percentage points from FY24.
 - 45% of elementary schools were rated “A,” an increase of 6 percentage points from FY24.
 - The District had the highest percentage of “A” rated middle schools among the seven largest Florida districts and the State.
 - 33 schools improved their letter grade.
 - Pine Jog Elementary and Rosenwald Elementary schools improved from a “C” to an “A.”
 - All of the schools that received a “D” in FY24 improved to a “C” in FY25 (Cholee Lake Elementary, Roosevelt Elementary, and West Riviera Elementary schools as well as Congress Middle).

Tables 2a-2e contain the numbers and percentages of school grades for Florida and District-operated elementary, middle, high, combination, and charter schools. Tables 3a–3e contain the percentages of letter grades for District-operated elementary, middle, high, combination, and charter schools in the seven large urban Florida districts. Table 4 contains District grades for the seven large urban Florida districts. Table 5 includes school grade components for each Palm Beach school.
