The Hillsboro School District Safety Care Team is committed to reducing the number of restraints and seclusions across the district. This year, the team met monthly to review individual student cases and programs requiring additional support, ensuring consistency in training and practices. In collaboration with Student Services, the team provided staff with strategies and tools to move away from the use of seclusions. Monthly refresher courses were offered to all district employees trained in Safety Care, with an emphasis on de-escalation and problem-solving techniques. Safety Care trainers worked directly with school teams to implement proactive and preventative de-escalation strategies. Additionally, Student Intervention Systems Trainers reviewed student incident reports weekly and followed up with school teams to offer targeted support or side-by-side coaching in de-escalation practices.

With the information provided above, the Hillsboro School District continues to offer ongoing training, education and practical guidance on responding to and supporting students who exhibit challenging behaviors.
