

BOARD MEMBER COMPENSATION

While Wishram School District does not collect levy funds, Wishram Board of Directors will not collect compensation.

In the event that Wishram School District does begin to collect levy funds, pursuant to state law, board members may receive compensation of fifty dollars per day, or pro-rated portion thereof, for attending board meetings and for performing other services on behalf of the school district, not to exceed four thousand eight hundred dollars per year. Such compensation must come from locally collected excess levy funds available for that purpose and shall not cause the state to incur any present or future funding obligation.

Any board member may waive all or any portion of such compensation for any month or months during his/her term of office, by a written waiver filed with the district. The waiver may be filed any time after the director's election and before the date on which the compensation would otherwise be paid. The waiver shall specify the month or period of months for which it is made.
