

Nonresident Students Procedures

Procedures Regarding Choice Transfers

All choice transfer students that go through the appropriate procedures to enroll in Wishram School will be considered for enrollment. There will be several factors that lead to the students approval or denial, and those factors include but are not limited to behavior (including attendance) at previous schools, academic performance (credits earned) at previous schools, and space availability. Each grade combination cannot exceed 15 students due to the constraints of our building. If more than 15 students already exist in the specific grade level requested, the student will be placed on a waiting list on a first come first served basis. Students that are approved for enrollment will have to submit to the following conditions:

1. Students that are approved for enrollment will have an intake hearing, which will serve as an interview for the parents and students to ensure that Wishram School is the appropriate placement for the student.

2. Students that are approved for enrollment will have to enter into a "Choice Transfer" contract which will set expectations for behavior, attendance, and academics, and failure to meet the stipulations of that contract can result in the revocation of enrollment at Wishram School.
The Superintendent will have final rights of approval or denial of choice transfer students.
