

Declaration of Exigent Circumstances

In conformance with Greene v. Camreta (9th Cr. 2009), school personnel must have proof of a warrant, court order, or the existence of exigent circumstances before providing access to a student within the school for an interview if there has not been prior consent by either the parent or student, depending on the age of the student, for such interview.

If a law enforcement official indicates below that exigent circumstances exist, school personnel shall make the child available for an interview with the law enforcement official. School personnel may remain present during the interview on school property, unless the student indicates they do not want any school personnel present during the interview.
