***Starting Preparedness Month Early***

(*Fullerton, CA*) – On Friday, October 7, 2022, Fullerton School District’s Robert C. Fisler School hosted a new administrator training focused on conducting a Level 4 Emergency Drill for an earthquake. The drill included Fullerton School District (FSD) personnel, school site administrators, and the City of Fullerton’s Emergency Manager in a simulation opening of the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) in response to a magnitude 7.8 earthquake.

The emergency command center simulation included a medical/triage response to injured students and staff, parent and child reunification, search and rescue, and other essential emergency responses needed to support students, staff, and families.

Although the focus of this drill at Fisler School was to train new FSD administrators, it also served as a kick off to the upcoming GREAT SHAKE OUT on October 20, 2022. The entire FSD will be participating in the Great Shake Out at 10:20 a.m. on October 20, 2022.

The Fullerton School District is located in northern Orange County, California and serves over 11,600 students in grades TK – 8<sup>th</sup>.
