unanimously that pursuant to California Education Code section 48916, a rehabilitation plan be developed by the superintendent or designee and recommended to the student and the student's parents for completion during the period of expulsion. Admission to the high school district at the end of the expulsion period will be contingent upon satisfactory completion of the rehabilitation plan.

The student may apply for admission to the high school district for the Fall semester of the 2002/2003 school year. Moved by Lynn Thornley, seconded by Marjorie Pogue and carried unanimously that pursuant to California Education Code section 48916, a rehabilitation plan be developed by the superintendent or designee and recommended to the student and the student's parents for completion during the period of expulsion. Admission to the high school district at the end of the expulsion period will be contingent upon satisfactory completion of the rehabilitation plan.
