MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

A Special meeting of the Fullerton School District Board of Trustees was called to order by President Ellen Ballard at 9:12 a.m. President Ballard led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

CLOSED SESSION

The Board recessed into Closed Session at 9:15 a.m. and conducted Expulsion Hearing 01/02-10 pursuant to Education Code section 48900(c). The Board recessed into deliberation at 10:00 a.m.

OPEN SESSION

The Board returned to Open Session at 10:10 a.m. Moved by Lynn Thornley, seconded by Robert Fisler and carried unanimously (3-0) that the student be expelled from all the schools and programs of the District for the semester in which the act occurred and the following semester. The Board further finds that other means of correction are not feasible or have repeatedly failed to bring about proper conduct, and due to the nature of the

act, the presence of the student causes a continuing danger to the physical safety of the student or others. The student may apply for readmission on or after the beginning of Spring semester, January 28, 2003. Moved by Lynn Thornley, seconded by Robert Fisler and carried unanimously (3-0) that pursuant to California Education Code section 48916, a rehabilitation plan be developed by the superintendent or designee and recommended to the student and the student's parents for completion during the period of expulsion. Admission to the school district at the end of the expulsion period will be contingent upon satisfactory completion of the rehabilitation plan.
