CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

A Special meeting of the Fullerton School District Board of Trustees was called to order by Vice President Ellen Ballard on Wednesday, December 5, 2001, at 11:45 a.m.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments at this time.

CLOSED SESSION

The Board recessed into Closed Session at 11:50 a.m. and conducted Expulsion Hearing 01/02-04 pursuant to Education Code section 48900(c). The Board recessed into deliberation at 12:25 p.m.

OPEN SESSION

The Board returned to Open Session at 12:40 p.m. Moved by Lynn Thornley, seconded by Marjorie Pogue and carried unanimously that the student be expelled as required by Education Code section 48915(d) in that the Board finds that the student committed or attempted to commit a sexual assault or committed sexual battery. Moved by Lynn Thornley, seconded by Marjorie Pogue and carried unanimously that the findings and

conclusions of the Board be adopted, and the Board refers the student to a program of study appropriately prepared to accommodate students who exhibit discipline problems that is not provided at a comprehensive middle, junior, senior high school, or at an elementary school, and that is not provided at the school site attended by the student at the time of the suspension. The student may apply for readmission after Spring, 2002. Moved by Lynn Thornley, seconded by Marjorie Pogue and carried unanimously that pursuant to California Education Code section 48916, a rehabilitation plan be developed by the superintendent or designee and recommended for the student and that student's parents for completion during the period of expulsion. Readmission to the District at the end of the expulsion period will be contingent upon satisfactory completion of the rehabilitation plan.
