1b. PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments at this time.

CLOSED SESSION

The Board recessed into Closed Session at 1:05 p.m. and conducted Expulsion Hearing 00/01-03 pursuant to Education Code section 48900(c). The Board recessed into deliberation at 2:05 p.m.

OPEN SESSION

The Board returned to Open Session at 2:15 p.m. Moved by Ellen Ballard, seconded by Marjorie Pogue and carried unanimously that the findings and conclusions of the Board be adopted and that the student be expelled from all the schools and programs of the District

for the remainder of the semester in which the act occurred and the following semester. Pursuant to Education Code section 48916, a rehabilitation plan is to be developed by the superintendent or designee and recommended for the student and the student's parents for completion during the period of the expulsion. The student may apply for readmission on or after April 6, 2001.

CLOSED SESSION

The Board recessed into Closed Session at 2:25 p.m. and conducted Expulsion Hearing 00/01-04 pursuant to Education Code section 48900(c). The Board recessed into deliberation at 3:30 p.m.

OPEN SESSION

The Board returned to Open Session at 3:55 p.m. Moved by Ellen Ballard, seconded by Lynn Thornley and carried unanimously that the findings and conclusions of the Board be adopted and that the student be expelled from all the schools and programs of the District for the remainder of the semester in which the act occurred. The student may apply for readmission on or after January 26, 2001.

CLOSED SESSION

The Board recessed into Closed Session at 4:07 p.m. and conducted Expulsion Hearing 00/01-05 pursuant to Education Code section 48900(c). The Board recessed into deliberation at 5:03 p.m.

OPEN SESSION

The Board returned to Open Session at 5:25 p.m. Moved by Ellen Ballard, seconded by Marjorie Pogue and carried unanimously that the findings and conclusions of the Board be adopted and that the student be expelled from all the schools and programs of the District for the remainder of the semester in which the act occurred and the following semester. It is also moved, however, that the order of expulsion be suspended for the second semester during the period of expulsion and that the student be placed on probationary status. The student shall be assigned to another school during the period of the suspended expulsion as determined by the superintendent or designee. It is also moved that, pursuant to California Education Code section 48916, a rehabilitation plan be developed by the superintendent or designee and recommended for the student and the student's parents for completion during the period of expulsion. Readmission to the District at the end of the expulsion period will be contingent upon satisfactory completion of the rehabilitation plan.
