The Board recessed into Closed Session at 8:35 a.m. and conducted Expulsion Hearing 00/01-16 pursuant to Education Code section 48900(c). The Board recessed into deliberation at 9:10 a.m.

**OPEN SESSION**

The Board returned to Open Session at 9:17 a.m. Moved by Ellen Ballard, seconded by Marjorie Pogue and carried unanimously that the student be expelled from all the schools and programs of the District for the semester in which the act occurred and the following semester. The Board further finds that due to the nature of the act, the presence of the

student causes a continuing danger to the physical safety of the student or others. The student may apply for readmission on or after the Fall semester in the 2001/2002 school year. Moved by Marjorie Pogue, seconded by Ellen Ballard, and carried unanimously that pursuant to California Education Code section 48916, a rehabilitation plan be developed by the superintendent or designee and recommended for the student and the student's parents for completion during the period of expulsion. Readmission to the District at the end of the expulsion period will be contingent upon satisfactory completion of the rehabilitation plan.
